CIRCULAR NO.1 DATED, 15.03.1996.

The Inauguration of the Central Government Health Scheme at Trivandrum has been tentatively fixed for 26th of March 1996 and the first dispensary of CGHS, Trivandrum at Sasthamangalam will start functioning from 1st April 1996.

The area covered by the above mentioned dispensary will have the following boundaries.

NORTH : from Thoppumukku Junction to Mannarskossa Jn. & further to Mannamaoola Jn. & Peroorkada Jn.

WEST : from Peroorkada Jn. to Ambalamukku Jn. & Lower down to Kowdiar Jn. & then along Kowdiar Avenue to Vellayambalam Jn. & then along Vazhuthacau Road to Vazhuthacau Jn.

SOUTH : from Vazhuthacau Jn. to DPI Jn. & further to Mandapam Jn. & then to Poojappura Jn. & then along Mahilamandiram Road to Thirumala Jn. & ~~then to the road to P.T.P. Nagar to Elipode to Acappura, Vattiyorkavu.~~

EAST : from Thirumala Jn. to the road leading to Neyyartam to Valiyavila Jn. and then by an imaginary line running to the east of Pattom, Thanu Pillai Nagar, Vattiyorkavu & Karimkulam to Thoppumukku Jn. so that all the above mentioned areas are within the covered area.

The important areas covered within the above mentioned boundary lines are as follows.

A map of frivandrum showing boundaries of Sasthamangalam Dispensary and the areas covered by the dispensary is displayed at the dispensary premises as well as the CGHS Office premises at Poomkulam CGO Complex. All Central Government departments are hereby requested to get the areas demarcated in their own maps which they may bring when they visit the office for collecting the CGHS Identity and Index Cards.

A person from each department may be deputed with letter of authorisation to collect the above mentioned cards after identifying the approximate No. of Central Government employees residing within the covered areas.

The issuing authorities are requested to ensure that (1) Only the members of family dependant and residing with the Government servant are entered in the CGHS Identity and Index Cards and (2) mention the date of birth against each member of the family including the card holder. Thereafter the part B of the index card is to be retained with the issuing authority and part A of the Index Card to the dispensary after getting his identity card stamped "Index Card Received" and initialed by the clerk of the dispensary. The beneficiaries can avail treatment at the dispensary only after depositing the Part A of the Index card with them on every occasion they visit the dispensary to avail treatment at the dispensary.

The dispensary will function between 7.30 AM to 1.30 PM from Monday to Saturday and will remain closed on Sundays and holidays. Central Government pensioners and freedom fighters residing anywhere in the state are entitled for CGHS facilities after obtaining CGHS identity cards from the Office of the Deputy Director CGHS, Trivandrum after completing the formalities required.
